OUTREACH AND COLLABORATION

- Worked with the Holocaust and Human Rights Education Center on arrangements for their Middle School Students Institute held at the Library on October 29. One hundred students attended. .
- Met with a health educator to arrange for a series of programs on the plant-based lifestyle for December.
- Attended a panel on Domestic Violence at Westchester Community College as part of the on-going Westchester County Safer Communities Initiative on October
 Met with organizers to discuss the possibility of duplicating the presentation for library staff at the Westchester Library System.

PROGRAMMING AND EXHIBITS

- Finalized arrangements for the Creative Aging grant program with a professional photographer who will teach an 8 session digital photography workshop for seniors in winter, 2016.
- Monitored the Westchester Readers meet Westchester Writers program on October 3. Forty people attended.
- Coordinated the Westchester Food Bank Distribution on October 21. More than 300 people were served.
